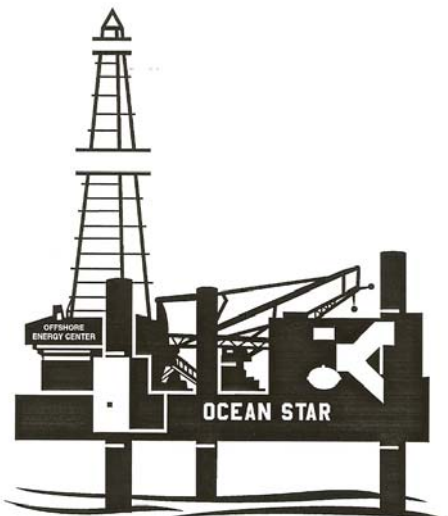

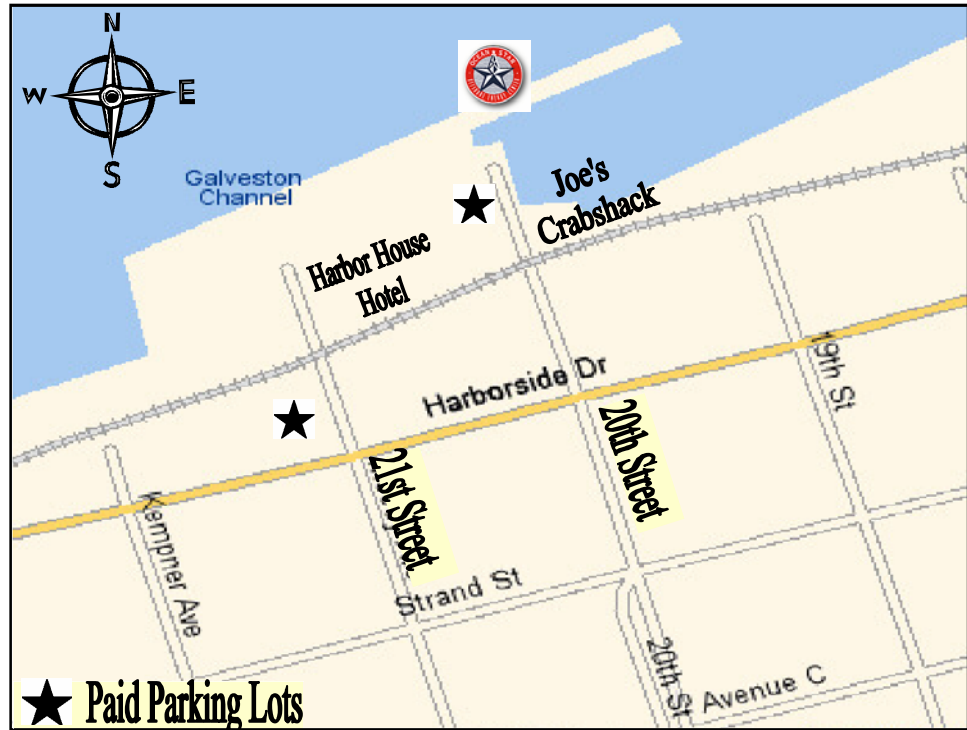


Driving & Parking Information

Getting to the Ocean Star

- Take I-45 South to Galveston Island
- Immediately after crossing the causeway onto Galveston, take the Harborside Drive Exit (EXIT 1C). It will say "Port of Galveston" or "Hospital."
- Turn left on Harborside Drive and follow it to the public parking lots at the intersection of Harborside Drive and 21st Street (about 5 miles)
- From Harborside Drive, you will see the *Ocean Star* on your left.
- The *Ocean Star* entrance is on the east end of Pier 20.

Where can I park?

Parking is limited on the pier, and we do not control any of the parking lots. Please be prepared to pay for parking. There are a few low-cost paid parking spots by the *Ocean Star*, on the section of 20th Street between Joe's Crab Shack and the museum's entrance. Please note this parking area is a "box lot" where there is no attendant on duty. Insert your money in the slot that corresponds to your parking space.

There are multiple pay lots within eyesight of the *Ocean Star*. They range in price from \$5 to \$10 for all day. The closest gated lot is located at 21st Street and Harborside Drive. Enter the LEFT (or Western) lot and then walk over to the museum.

We are not able to validate parking tickets. However, restaurants located in the area will validate with purchase.
