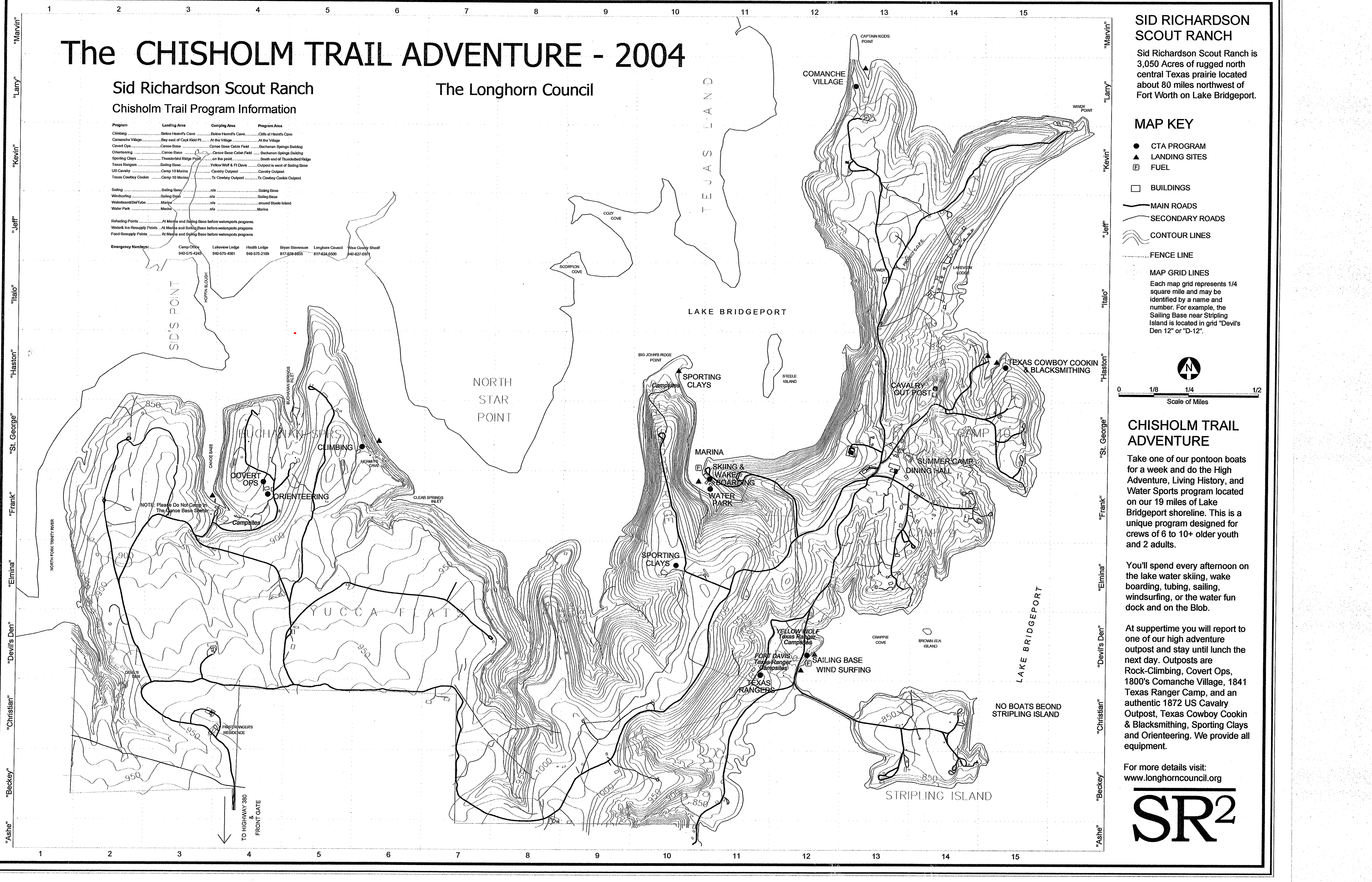

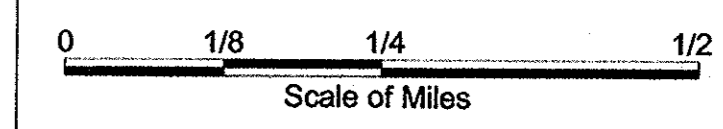


SID RICHARDSON SCOUT RANCH

Sid Richardson Scout Ranch is 3,050 Acres of rugged north central Texas prairie located about 80 miles northwest of Fort Worth on Lake Bridgeport.

CHISHOLM TRAIL ADVENTURE

Take one of our pontoon boats for a week and do the High Adventure, Living History, and Water Sports program located on our 19 miles of Lake Bridgeport shoreline. This is a unique program designed for crews of 6 to 10+ older youth and 2 adults.

You'll spend every afternoon on the lake water skiing, wake boarding, tubing, sailing, windsurfing, or the water fun dock and on the Blob.

At suppertime you will report to one of our high adventure outpost and stay until lunch the next day. Outposts are Rock-Climbing, Covert Ops, 1800's Comanche Village, 1841 Texas Ranger Camp, and an authentic 1872 US Cavalry Outpost, Texas Cowboy Cookin' & Blacksmithing, Sporting Clays and Orienteering. We provide all equipment.
